



Dear Facilitator,

How to Facilitate a School of Worship:

The following is a rough outline on how we recommend running the course. The timeline and order is flexible, but you should comfortably finish in less than 2 hours.

* Welcome Students

- First class, read welcome letter from Pastor Tom Inglis. Subsequent classes welcome the students and open in a short prayer asking the Lord to bless the time together.

* Praise and Worship - (10 -15 minutes)

- Supply own music (CD, guitar/singers)

* Start Lesson on DVD - (40 minutes on average)

- Before lesson starts facilitator to read out the key point of the lesson in the workbook. Remind students to use 'class notes' page in Workbook at the front of each lesson.

* Short Break - (10 minutes)

* Assessment - (5 -10 minutes). As a facilitator you will have access to the answers for the students to go over with them after the assessment.

- 'A' in P.R.A.I.S.E.

* Break into groups of 2-3 for interaction (discuss) the lesson. - (15 minutes)

- 'I' in P.R.A.I.S.E.

* Groups share ideas in open forum with all students present. - (10 minutes)

- 'I' in P.R.A.I.S.E.

* End in Prayer

The student at home completes the workbook assignments before the next lesson. It is important to encourage them to do the assignments so that they give themselves the maximum opportunity to develop a lifestyle of worship.
